

Mummy Mountain Information from PMPC Board Member Teresa Zachariah:

Just a few short months ago many PMPC Members added their name to stop Camelback Mountain from being permanently scarred. Our neighbors on Mummy Mountain have reached out to us with an issue again being raised at the Board Of Adjustment for a variance ... to simply not to have to abide by the Hillside Ordinance. On my review, at least this time, the town's staff is recommending denial - hopefully we can continue to make sure that building abides by our codes and ordinances.

The present variance request is asking to more than double the amount of disturbed area on the side of Mummy Mountain at 5211 East Cheney Drive Paradise Valley AZ 85253. The Board of Adjustment will make a decision on June 7th at 5:30 p.m. Here's how you can help to help stop out of control construction on our mountains - this time Mummy Mountain.

1. Write a letter to the Board of Adjustment asking them to deny the variance and stop the expansion of disturbed area on the hill side.
